

Out & about with bub

Designed for children under 5 and their carers, follow winding paths through colourful gardens, see playful water features, stroll along the banks of the lake—home to the resident ducks—and whoop it up at the playground.

The 'out & about with bub' walk runs for 45 minutes and is stroller friendly. It departs from Melange café every Wednesday and Friday at 10am.



Bookings are not essential but playgroups should advise the Parkland if there are more than 10 carers with strollers. Auslan interpreters can be booked free of charge for deaf and hearing impaired children or groups. Bookings for this service needs to be in advance (at least 24 hours).

Guided walks

Roma Street Parkland offers a wide variety of free guided walks. The walks vary in length and time and we are more than happy to tailor each walk to suit each group's individual needs.



General walks

Make the most of your visit to the Parkland by taking part in a guided walk. Find out more about the spectacular flora and fauna and take a closer look at some of the pieces of art and other sights the Parkland has to offer.

General daily walks depart from The Hub at 10am and 2pm and run for 1 hour throughout the Parkland.

Bookings are only essential for groups of 10 or more and 4 weeks notice is required.

Specialised walks

Auslan interpreter walk

The Auslan interpreter walks are based around our general walks and include a sign language interpreter alongside our volunteer guide, presenting the walk.

Art walk

Take a look at the many interesting pieces of art within the Parkland and find out more about how they are incorporated into the horticultural and historical components of the Parkland.

Heritage walk

This walk will take visitors through the varied and colourful history of the Parkland, focusing on its former uses, the people and groups that occupied the site and continuing through to the development of Roma Street Parkland in 2001.

Sensory walk

Aimed at stimulating the senses, memory and mood the sensory walk is designed for individuals that are vision impaired or those with brain injuries. This walk is largely based around the quiet surrounds of the Spectacle Garden and the Forest. The sensory walk is available to any group.

Curator's walk

Go behind the scenes and gain a better understanding of the design and planning of the gardens.

Each walk is different giving you the chance to find out more about seasonal blooming plants, information on sub-tropical gardening or even the history of the Parkland.
